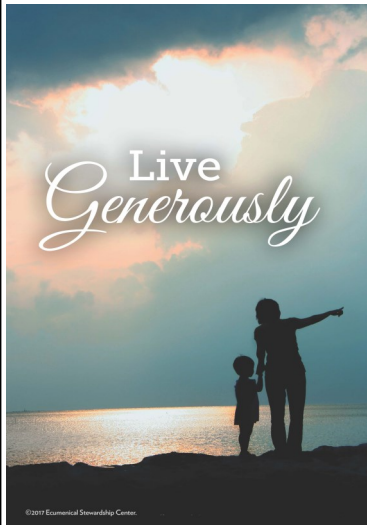
Let's fill the pews on January 6. **That** would be a great welcome gift!!
